## Year 1 Visit to Whipsnade Zoo

As part of the Year 1 Spring Term curriculum enquiry question 'How can we save animals around the world?' the children in Year 1 will be going on a trip to Whipsnade Zoo. They will be able to experience seeing the animals that we are learning about up close and take part in an exciting workshop designed to help them understand different animal habitats around the world.
